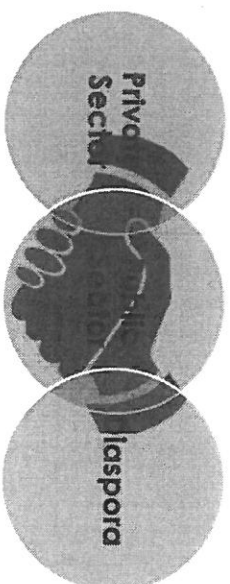
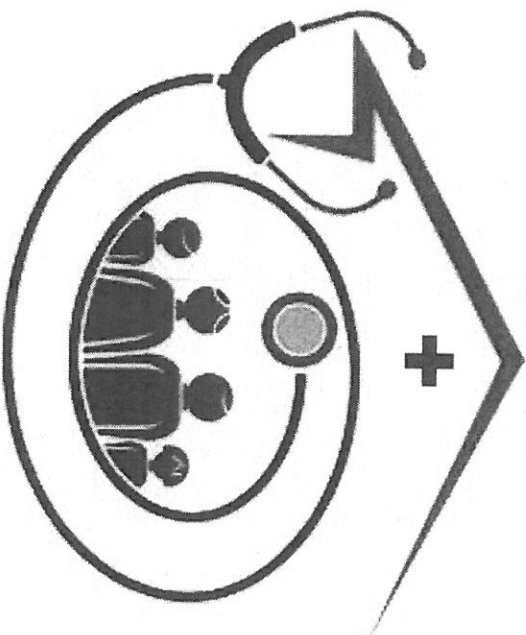

#### ADPT-A-CLINIC PROGRAMME A Primary Care Renewal Strategic Initiative

The Adopt-A-Clinic Programme is a structured arrangement that seeks to engage the private sector locally and the Diaspora to play a critical role in improving the provision and access to Primary Health Care via the philanthropic support to a pool of 100 clinics identified for Adoption.

#### Background

- Primary Health Care in Jamaica is delivered through a network of over 320 Community Health Centres spread across the nation's 14 parishes.
- Most facilities were built in the 1970s, and Jamaica received global recognition from the World Health Organization (WHO) then for its best practices in Primary Health Care.
- Over the past 6 years Jamaica invested J\$1.5 Billion on refurbishing and equipping 150 of these health centres, but many challenges persist due to limiting space at health centres, increased population, change in demographics and epidemiological profile, deteriorating infrastructure, inadequate maintenance, aging equipment and the limited fiscal resources of the government.
- Over the years philanthropic assistance makes a very important contribution to the health sector in Jamaica. In 2017 and 2016 the value of charitable contributions to the Jamaican health sector was estimated to be J\$967M (US\$7.5M) and J\$512M (US\$4M) respectively.
- The Adopt-A-Clinic Programme is a strategic initiative that seeks to proactively leverage the philanthropic support of the private sector and diaspora to play a more critical role in improving the very important Primary Health Care System.

#### Needs of Clinics

- ✓ Minor Infrastructure upgrade/expansion
- ✓ Minor maintenance/repairs
- ✓ Acquisition of clinical, dental, office equipment, and furniture

- Your level of financial support (the Programme seeks to obtain commitment per clinic of US\$5 – \$10 thousand dollars or J\$1,000,000 equivalent per year for a period of 3 – 5 years).

#### 3. FORMALIZE ADOPTION – Become Officially Recognized as an Adopter:

- Review and Sign Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
- Make arrangements for Payment of committed funds
- Attend launch of Adoption
